DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Execute mine plan, build and sustain relationship with employees, shared services, mining contractor, neighbors, customers, community and government agencies.
- Efficiently manage the day-to-day quarry and quality functions to ensure safety, quality, environmental, regulatory and production requirements are met. Assist as required in all management responsibilities.
- After successful transition this position will assume the lead in the management and implementation of Graymont's uniform environmental standards, ensuring environmental compliance. Evaluate projects and processes for continuous improvements: equipment selection and replacement. Participate in the operational and capital budgeting processes.
- Working in a team environment, coordinate and manage multiple projects and assignments, analyze data, troubleshoot quarry and plant operations and assist in the creation and implementation of solutions.
- Supervise the Quality Assurance Lab and oversee analytical testing methods, including but not limited to: wet bench chemistry, XRF, LECO Carbon and Sulfur Analysis.
- Coach and develop lab/environmental technicians and quarry employees to perform at their highest most efficient levels. Support team building and employee development with all Indian Creek employees.
- Support CEM equipment and flue gas analyzers used in air quality control and combustion monitoring equipment.
- Perform "on call" duties on rotation with the supervisory team.
- Other duties and projects as may be assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Proven track record of developing and maintaining a safe work culture.
- Proven teambuilding and leadership skills
- Bachelor of Science in earth sciences or engineering preferred or equivalent combination of experience and education.
- Minimum of three years of practical experience in a quarry and production environment.
